Academia del Pueblo (ADP) has diligently been planning and preparing for reopening for the 2022-2023 school year, while ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of students, staff, and community. Countless individuals have invested their time and expertise to develop this plan.

2022-23 Regular Schedule. All students return to in-person learning, five (5) days per week. In alignment with the Governor's executive order, March 2021, Academia del Pueblo Elementary has adopted reopening criteria for in-person learning that align closely with the recommendations provided by the Arizona Department of Public Health.

Safety Mitigation Plan

These are the COVID-19 Protocols for students, staff, families, visitors and anyone entering the campus of Academia del Pueblo Elementary. Covid-19 Policies

- Face masks are OPTIONAL for all students, staff and visitors, while on campus.
- Face masks OPTIONAL on school buses
- Desk shields are optional for teachers in classrooms. Social distancing implemented when possible
- Limited capacity for parents and visitors on campus for scheduled events
- The school will resume normal recess schedule
- Modified seating arrangements during lunch
- Hand washing stations on school grounds
- Water bottle filling stations
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting schedule
- Hand sanitizing stations in each classroom and on bus

Campus Safety Policies

- Parents and visitors are allowed by appointment ONLY
- The school is a closed campus. No visitors in the classrooms, unless by appointment
- Classroom parties are for students ONLY. ONLY store-bought food allowed.
- The school is a single source entry campus
- The school utilizes an electronic entry access door to enter the school (staffed at all times)

- The school is a fully locked campus with key access required through campus gates
- The school has an active, live camera system with 25 live campus views monitored at all times by 4 team members
- The school conducts schoolwide lock down drills every month
- The school conducts an Active Shooter Training for staff annually (this is a new training for the FY 23 school year)
